Musical and Bookings Policy:

- To book artistes who play "modern" or "mainstream" jazz; that is, jazz as developed from 1945 up to the present day;
- To book local, regional and, as the financial circumstances permit, national or international artistes.

Objectives:

- To maintain the presence of live modern / mainstream jazz on a regular basis at a venue in Market Harborough;
- To provide a programme of jazz (within the terms of the M&B policy) to meet the needs of the Club Members;
- To ensure that jazz concerts are an informal and enjoyable community event.

Venue:

The venue for concerts by Harborough Jazz is in the Garden Room of the Angel Hotel, High Street, Market Harborough. Access to this room is direct from the High Street by a side entrance. There is sufficient space for a maximum audience of 70 people seated, mainly at tables. There is an integral bar, and those attending are able to enjoy a drink during the performances. At lunchtime a limited range of hot and cold refreshments is available from the hotel; however, these must be pre-ordered by 1.00pm. The central town location of the hotel means that there is plenty of parking available either on the street or in nearby council car parks. There is only limited parking at the back of the hotel.

Date and Time:

Concerts will generally be held on the SECOND Sunday of each month from September to June each season, with a break in July and August. They will commence at 12.30pm, with the doors open for the purchase of tickets from 12.00 noon. There will be a break of approximately 20 minutes for lunch from about 1.20pm until 1.40pm. Concerts will end at about 2.30-2.45pm.

Membership Scheme and Benefits:

The Membership Subscription is currently **£12** per annum. Payment may be made by cash or cheque.

It is not necessary to be a Member to attend Harborough Jazz. However, the benefit to Members is that the admission price for a concert will be at least £2 less, for a Member and one accompanied Member's Guest, than for a Non-Member. Members are able to book admission for themselves and one accompanied Member's Guest in advance by post. Members get priority booking over Non-Members up to one week before the concert. Members also receive a Newsletter twice each year.

Admission Prices:

Admission prices will vary from £6 / £8 to £15 / £17 (Members & Guests / Non-Members) according to the stature of the artiste. The Committee reserves the right to vary these prices as it sees fit for the particular artiste(s) concerned.

Note that a Membership Card must be shown on arrival in order to obtain the Members Discount.

A Member may buy two discounted tickets; one for him/herself, and one for an accompanied Member's Guest.
