The **Robert Smyth School Big Band** is from Market Harborough. Its members are led by the musical director, Helle Petersen, who is a big band and swing music enthusiast. The RSSBB has been Winners and Finalists at many competitions in the UK during the period 2006-09. It has toured widely abroad, and is appearing at JOASD immediately prior to departure to represent the UK at the International Society for Music Education 29th World Conference in Beijing.

The **Harborough Jazz Combo** is a group of local musicians who often appear at the regular Harborough Jazz Sunday gigs. They will be led by our very own Dr Len Holden.

The **Vic Ash / Simon Spillett Quintet** comprises **Vic Ash** (clarinet, tenor sax) **Simon Spillett** (tenor sax) **John Critchinson** (keyboards) **Alec Dankworth** (bass) and **Martin Drew** (drums).

Vic is a long standing member of the British jazz scene. He has led his own quintet, played with John Dankworth, been a veteran of the BBC Big Band, and toured both in Europe and the USA. **Simon** won a BBC Jazz Award as ‘Rising Star’ in 2007, and Jazz Journal’s ‘Record Of The Year’ in 2008. As a teenager, he took lessons from Vic. He is a regular member of Ronnie Scott’s Jazz Orchestra, and has played with John Dankworth, Alan Barnes, Tony Coe and Peter King. **John** joined Simon in 2005. He had been a regular member of the Ronnie Scott Quintet from the late 70’s until the demise of the band in 1995, when he formed a band with Art Themen and Dave Green. He has also played with Chet Baker, James Moody, Joe Henderson and Johnny Griffin. **Alec**, son of the late John Dankworth, is one of Britain’s leading bass players. From 1998-2001 he was a member of the Dave Brubeck Quartet. He has played with the US stars Mose Allison, Johnny Griffin, Marian McPartland and Clark Terry, and with British musicians Stan Tracey, Courtney Pine and Tommy Smith. He has appeared before at HJ gigs. **Martin** has been playing for more than 50 years. He played with Ronnie Scott for 20 years, was a member of the Oscar Peterson Trio, and has played with the A to Z of jazz stars. Without doubt Britain’s leading jazz drummer he now co-leads the New Couriers, paying tribute to the music of the likes of Tubby Hayes, Ronnie Scott and Clark Terry. He has appeared before at HJ gigs.
